Sub: Calling applications for filling up the post of Principal Advisor(legal) on deputation on foreign service basis.

Sir,

The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), New Delhi, is a statutory body set up under an Act of Parliament viz. the TRAI Act, 1997. The organization proposes to prepare a panel of Officers having required experience in the legal field for appointment as Principal Advisor(Legal) on deputation on *foreign service terms initially for a period of two years*. The details of qualification and experience, etc., are as under:-

No.	Name of the Post	Scale of Pay and allowances	Qualification/experience
1.	Principal Advisor (legal)	Rs.37400 – 67000 + Grade Pay Rs.12000/- plus allowances such as DA, HRA, CCA etc. as per Govt. Rules.	Officers of the Central Govt., Public Sector Undertakings and Statutory and Autonomous Bodies (i) holding equivalent post on regular basis or (ii) officers in Senior Administrative grade with 6 years of regular service in that grade or (iii) Group A officers having twenty six years of regular service in Group A of which at least 6 years continuous service shall be in the Senior Administrative Grade. Essential: A Master/Bachelor's Degree in Law from a recognized University/Institution and possessing requisite experience in the related field <u>Job Content:</u> Officers having adequate knowledge in drafting primary and subordinate legislation shall be preferred. Age: Not exceeding 56 years on date of closing of applications.

2. The Appointing Authority may, from time to time, by appropriate order, appoint on permanent absorption basis any person already appointed on deputation in the Authority in accordance with the provisions contained in TRAI Appointment Regulations.

3. TRAI has been exempted from the rule of immediate absorption upto 23.01.2011 by Department of Pension & Pensioner's Welfare for appointment on deputation. However TRAI has taken up the matter with the Government for exemption from the applicability of the rule of immediate absorption for all posts in TRAI.

4. All the Ministries/Departments, Public Sector Undertakings and Statutory and Autonomous Bodies are requested to forward applications in the enclosed proforma (can also be down loaded from TRAI website: www.traigov.in) alongwith attested copies of ACRs for the last five years and vigilance / disciplinary clearance of eligible candidates whose services could be placed at the disposal of the Authority immediately in an envelope superscribing the post applied for so as to reach the Senior Research Officer (A&P), Telecom Regulatory Authority of India, Mahanagar Door Sanchar Bhawan, J.L. Nehru Marg, (Old Minto Road), Next to Zakir Husain College, New Delhi – 110002 on or before **12th June 2009**.
