Dr. P.D. Vaghela, Chairman, TRAI shared views in the virtual session on "Towards the new concept of the Regulatory Framework" during the 22nd APT Policy and Regulatory Forum (PRF-22) held from 19-21 July 2022

1. Consultation Papers

1. TRAI released a Consultation Paper on "Spectrum Requirements of National Capital Region Transport Corporation (NCRTC) for Train Control System for RRTS Corridors"



Department of Telecommunications (DoT) through their letter dated 29th November 2021 informed TRAI that National Capital Region Transport Corporation (NCRTC) has requested DoT for allotment of spectrum for Train Control System for Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) being implemented by NCRTC in 8 rail corridors. It includes 3 rail corridors of approximate length of 350 Km along Delhi – Ghaziabad – Meerut, Delhi – Gurugram – Alwar, Delhi – Panipat in Phase-I.

In this background, DoT requested TRAI to provide:

- (i) Recommendations on administrative assignment of spectrum to NCRTC and the quantum, pricing/charging thereof and any other terms and conditions, for separate spectrum requirements of NCRTC in 700 MHz band.
- (ii) Any other recommendations deemed fit for the purpose, including assignment of the same spectrum for other RRTS/Metro rail network pan-India.

In this regard, a Consultation Paper on "Spectrum Requirements of National Capital Region Transport Corporation (NCRTC) for Train Control System for RRTS Corridors", was released on 9th June 2022 seeking inputs from the stakeholders and placed on TRAI's website (www.trai.gov.in). Through the consultation paper, specific issues on the subject matter have been raised for consideration of stakeholders. Written comments on the issues raised in the Consultation Paper were invited from the stakeholders' comments and counter comments up to 14th July 2022 and 28th July 2022, respectively.

2.4 The release of the "Test Guide Document for CAS and SMS for Broadcasting sector" held on 15th June 2022

TRAI and Telecommunication Engineering Centre (TEC) released the "Test Guide Document for Conditional Access System (CAS) and Subscriber Management Systems (SMS) for Broadcasting Sector" on 15th June 2022. The release of the Test Guide document was held in the August presence of the Secretary (MIB) and Secretary (Telecom). Representatives from the industry, including major Broadcasters and Distribution Platform Operators (DPOs), expert bodies like C-DAC, STQC, BECIL, TEC and representatives from media participated in the event.

3.1 <u>Telecom Subscription Data as on 31st May 2022.</u>

Active wireless subscribers on the date of Peak VLR in May 2022 were 1017.68 million.

In May 2022, 7.97 million subscriber requests were made for MNP. By the end of May 2022, a total of 705.54 million consumers have availed the MNP facility since its implementation.

3.2 Panel of Auditors:

TRAI released an updated list of the panel of auditors to carry out digital addressable systems from time to time. In this context, the updated list for panel of auditors was released on 23rd June 2022.

3.3 Keeping in view the ongoing consultation process, which primarily discusses issues related to discount given in the formation of the bouquet, ceiling price of channels for inclusion in bouquet, and discount offered by broadcasters to DPOs in addition to distribution fee, TRAI has released a letter dated 1st June 2022 for extending the time limit for implementation of New Regulatory Framework as under:

- a. All the Broadcasters shall report to the Authority, any change in name, nature, language, Maximum Retail Price (MRP) per month of channels, composition of bouquets and MRP of bouquets of channels as per the New Regulatory Framework 2020, by 31st August 2022 and simultaneously publish such information on their website.
- b. All the Distribution Platform Operators shall report to the Authority, distributor Retail Price (DRP) of pay channels, composition of bouquet of Page 8 of 9

pay channels/free-to-air channels and DRP of bouquets of pay channels, as per the New Regulatory Framework 2020 by 30th September 2022, and simultaneously publish such information on their websites.

c. Further, all distributors of television channels should ensure that with effect from 30th November 2022, services to the subscribers are provided as per the bouquets or channels opted by the subscribers.
