Review of IUC

Sir,

TRAI is humbly requested to spare its thoughts for telecom consumers also as it keeps itself busy in ensuring profits and revenues for telecom industry.


Now telecom subscribers are able to obtain unlimited voice package from all operators for as less as 50 rupees per month. This is a beautiful arrangement if all companies offer this minimal plan for their subscribers.

However 2G/3G subscribers of telecom companies are not being offered these unlimited call packages. Instead they are offered very high call rates which were prevalent 15 years ago.

Therefore traffic imbalance is not being caused by new technologies but by old 2G/3G technologies which are not giving unlimited call facilities to the subscribers and are using the IUC model to profiteer from their old useless technologies.

TRAI should never succumb to selfish demands of these 2G/3G operators and it should instead mandate unlimited voice call package by all telecom operators irrespective of technology of network offered to the subscriber. This will ensure that all subscribers get technologically neutral bouquet of telecom services of data and unlimited voice. This measure itself will eliminate the traffic imbalance.
